ACADEMIC CRITERIA – Student Athlete Overseas Scholarship

Students who have competed locally and continue to train while at university and who intend to compete at the collegiate level can be considered Student Athletes. Documentation from the Sports Director of the institution attending must be provided for this designation to be awarded. This confirmation can be provided at the time of final unconditional acceptance at the end of the process and is not necessarily needed during the application stage.

- **All other academic criteria will apply at the discretion of Education Council.**

Please note that scholarship funding is not guaranteed, and the Education Council therefore reserves the following rights:

- to require all applicants to participate in a scholarship interview as part of the scholarship application process;
- to prioritise the award of scholarships by areas of study;
- to prioritise the award of scholarships by degree;
- to prioritise the award of scholarships based on the availability of funds as determined by Cabinet.
